




5.0L COYOTE ENGINE (2011 to present)

The development of the Coyote engine, 5.0 liter (302ci), was an engineering feat achieved at great expense by Ford Motor Company. It was developed to replace the 4.6 liter V8 and was introduced in 2011 in the Mustang GT. It featured dual overhead cams, 4 valves per cylinder and variable cam timing. Fuel is handled by low-pressure port injection system which was later improved with the addition of high-pressure direct injection. Its design borrowed heavily from the best engines in the world including racing engines and in fact the Coyote name has racing in its roots. It comes from the chassis that renowned race car driver A.J. Foyt used during his Indy career racing days in the 60's.

The engineers and designers developing the Coyote were tasked to build a remarkably advanced engine without noticeably increasing the physical size over the 4.6L. And in fact, they needed the power output to be on par with the larger Camaro (6.2L LS3 V-8) and Challenger (5.7L Hemi V-8) engines. The design of 4.6L was limited to 350hp. The Coyote maximum horsepower is almost unlimited.

There are four generations of the 5.0 Coyote each featuring improved emissions, fuel economy and durability.

- Gen 1 2011 – 2014 (420hp)
- Gen 2 2015 – 2017 (435hp)
- Gen 3 2018 – 2023 (460hp)
- Gen 4 2024 – 2025 (480hp)



There are variants of the basic Coyote engine featuring increased displacement at 5.2L (315ci), some of them are listed below

Voodoo 526hp – specifically for the Shelby GT350

Aluminator 580hp - crate engine

Predator 760hp - Shelby GT500 - utilizing a cross-plane crank and a supercharger

Other variations were

Road Runner 5.0L 444hp – used in the Boss 302 (2012-2013)

Trinity 5.8L 662hp used in the 2013-2014 GT500 while not based directly on the Coyote this engine is built on the same assembly line and shares many of the design features of the Coyote.

This very versatile engine has also found a home in the F-150.




